3. How does Our Site use Cookies

- 3.1. Our Site may place and access certain Cookies on your computer or device.
- 3.2. First party cookies are those placed directly by Us and are used only by Us. We use Cookies to facilitate and improve your experience of Our Site and provide and improve Our services. We have carefully chosen these Cookies and have taken steps to ensure that your privacy and personal data is protected and always respected.
- 3.3. You may also receive third party Cookies on your computer or device. Third party Cookies are those placed by websites, services and/or parties other than Us.
- 3.4. Our Site uses analytics Cookies to collect and analyse anonymous usage information, enabling Us to better understand how Our Site is used. This enables Us to improve Our Site and the services offered through it.

3.5. All Cookies use by and on Our Site are used in accordance with current Cookie Law. We may use some or all of the following types of Cookies as described in the below table.

Cookie type	Purpose
First party	Set by and directly stored by the website and enable the operator to advertise its own products and tailor the website to the visitor
Session	Only last for the time that a visitor is on a site and then disappear from the computer or device when the site is closed
Strictly necessary	Needed for the essential functioning of the website such as for sign in details, security settings, parental controls, shopping basket
Persistent	Remain on a computer or device after the browser has been closed, and last for a time specified by the cookie, these are used to remember a visitor's preferences for the next time they visit. They remain on a computer or device for a predetermined period and are activated each time the site is visited
Functional	Enable the website owner to provide additional features to visitors such as personalisation and remembering saved preferences. Some may also be strictly necessary for the running of the website
Performance	These make sure that a website is working properly and fix any errors
Analytics	These gather information about how a visitor uses the website for example, how efficiently they navigate around the site and what features are used
Targeting	Similar to analytics cookies these help a website owner understand how visitors use the site, when and how often they visit and which parts have been used. These cookies help website owners better understand their visitors and so advertising can be made more relevant/personalised. Some information gathered by targeting cookies may also be shared with third parties.
Third party	Set by someone other than the website owner but providing a service shared by the website owner, for example, YouTube, PayPal, Facebook may also be advertising
Advertising	These allow for targeted adverts to be shown to site visitors and may also be able to track an individual's browsing across different sites
